World of Color is Big!

Be awed by World of Color, a 25-minute nighttime spectacular that weaves water, color, fire and light into a kaleidoscope of imagination.

And be carried away by the soaring soundtrack that spans decades of these movies—from classics to the most recent releases.

On occasion, updates and changes are made to the World of Color show to include current illustrations of characters, like Merida from *Brave* and the cast from *Cars*.

Even the Numbers Are Large

This show is big—the most impressive and fanciful nighttime extravaganza Disney has ever produced. Nearly 1,200 fountains shoot water 200 feet into the air to create an approximately 19,000 square-foot water screen. The show also features many impressive pyrotechnics, fog and laser effects.

What Is Disney FASTPASS Service?

Disney FASTPASS Service provides first-come, first-served tickets to same day World of Color shows and many other attractions at the Disneyland Resort.

Ticket Distribution

Tickets are available when the park opens at the Grizzly River Run Disney FASTPASS Service machines.

How to Get a Ticket

Insert your scanned theme park admission ticket into the machine to obtain your Disney FASTPASS ticket printed with World of Color showtime, viewing area and return time.

At your designated return time, bring your Disney FASTPASS ticket with you to Paradise Park where Cast Members will direct you to the color-coded viewing area indicated on your ticket.

Additional Information

- As with other Disney FASTPASS attractions, a limited number of tickets are available and Guests will not be able to select a specific World of Color showtime.
- FASTPASS tickets will first be distributed for the earlier show, and after those have been distributed, FASTPASS tickets will then be distributed for the later show.
- After the limited World of Color FASTPASS tickets have been distributed, Grizzly River Run terminals will return to distributing Grizzly River Run FASTPASS tickets.

Viewing Area

All viewing areas for the approximately 25-minute World of Color show are standing only, with accommodations for Guests with disabilities.

The Paradise Park viewing area in Disney California Adventure Park is made up of large, open terraces that provide panoramic views of World of Color.

All areas are standing only.

Guests with Disabilities

For Guests with mobility disabilities there are designated wheelchair accessible locations in each viewing area.

For Guests with hearing disabilities, Disney's Handheld Devices, which provides assistive listening, can be used within the World of Color viewing area. Obtain a receiver (deposit required) at the Guest Relations Lobby inside Disney California Adventure Park.

Or simply sit back and relax at Paradise Pier. On warm days, kids can cool off in the park's wet play area, but please keep in mind, shoes are required.
